House design and construction

- Buildings typically circular between 5m and 8.50m in diameter
- Entrances generally south or east-facing,



Textile production

- Spindle whorls, used for spinning yarn, were recovered from 3 different sites
- A baked clay loom weight from Knockgraffon, indicates that weaving was being carried out there
