The National Roads Authority (the "Authority"), in exercise of the powers conferred under section 61 of the Roads Act, 1993, as amended, proposes to make bye-laws in respect of the use of the M3 Clonee to Kells Motorway.

The purpose of the bye-laws is to give effect to the Toll Scheme for the M3 Clonee to Kells Motorway as adopted by the Board of the Authority in March 2007.
