DRAFT BYE-LAWS FOR THE LIMERICK SOUTHERN RING ROAD PHASE II

The National Roads Authority (the “Authority”), in exercise of the powers conferred under section 61 of the Roads Act, 1993, as amended, proposes to make bye-laws in respect of the use of the Limerick Southern Ring Phase II.

The purpose of the bye-laws is to give effect to the Toll Scheme for the Limerick Southern Ring Phase II as adopted by the Board of the Authority.
