Toll Bye-Laws for the Limerick Southern Ring Road Phase II

The National Roads Authority (NRA), in exercise of the powers conferred under section 61 of the Roads Act, 1993, (as amended), has made Bye-Laws titled "Toll Bye-Laws for the Limerick Southern Ring Road Phase II". These Bye-Laws relate to the section of the road which will run from the existing Limerick Southern Ring Road Phase I at Rossbrien in County Limerick to the existing N18 at Cratloe Castle in County Clare, together with the link road (also a national road) connecting the mainline alignment at Coonagh West with the existing roundabout at Clonmacken in Limerick City.
