



Draft Bye-Laws for the M1 Motorway (Gormanston to Monasterboice)

The National Roads Authority, in exercise of the powers conferred under section 61 of the Roads Act, 1993, as amended by section 274 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, proposes to make bye-laws in respect of the use of the M1 Motorway (Gormanston to Monasterboice) scheme also known as the Drogheda Bypass.

The purpose of the bye-laws is to give effect to the Toll Scheme for the M1 Motorway (Gormanston to Monasterboice) as adopted by the Board of the Authority on the 14th May, 2002.
